'The Words I Should Have Said to Phoebe Lewis' is a fast-paced comedy about a young writer's journey of discovering love. After the death of his mother, Frank finds himself stuck in a world of late nights, drugs and empty relationships, until he meets Phoebe Lewis: the girl we all want to take to Pizza Hut. But he can't quite muster the courage to talk to her because, let's face it, she's in the thesaurus under the word 'perfect' and he's only a league two reserve.

Jim has previously written for the Hull Truck Young Writers programme and Park Bench Theatre. He trained at Rose Bruford on the BA Hons Acting course and was chosen to represent his year at the Spotlight Prize in 2013 where he performed his own writing. He won Monologue Slam in Manchester with his own monologue and has had students perform his writing at the Spotlight Prize 2013 and 2014. Since graduating he has worked as an actor at The Globe and Theatre Royal Plymouth and has just finished playing the lead in a play called 'Hurling Rubble at the Moon' at the Park Theatre directed by Jez Bond. He joined the Soho Young Writer's Group last summer after they saw his debut play 'The Words I Should Have Said to Phoebe Lewis' which is being performed at Hull Truck in July this year and is currently writing for Middle Child Theatre Company.
